14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That §20-2-21 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.
18	§20-2-21. Reporting beaver and otter pelts taken and tagged.
19	Each trapper shall present each Castor canadensis beaver <u>and</u>
20	otter, or its each pelt, to a game checking station or
21	representative of the division within thirty days after the close
22	of a legal season. A tag provided by the division shall be affixed
23	to each Castor canadensis beaver and otter, or each pelt and remain
24	attached to the <u>animal or</u> pelt until it is processed into
25	commercial fur.

(NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to add otter to the

species which must be checked at an official game check station.
