(b) Six hundred dollars shall be paid annually to each classroom teacher who has at least twenty years of teaching resperience. The payments: (i) Shall be in addition to any amounts prescribed in the applicable state minimum salary schedule; (ii) shall be paid in equal monthly installments; and (iii) shall be considered a part of the state minimum salaries for teachers.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a five percent increase in teacher's salaries for each of the following school years, 2010-2011, 2011-2012, 2012-2013, and also to add pay

increment categories for teachers with BA +30, +45 and Master's +60.
