22	Beginning July 1, 2011, all annuitants at least sixty years of
23	age and receiving an annuity from this system for at least five
24	years shall receive a cost-of-living increase in their monthly

- 1 annuity equal to the annual increase in the consumer price index as
- 2 published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor
- 3 Statistics. The maximum annual cost-of-living increase may not
- 4 exceed five percent of the base monthly annuity.
