20	§20-2B-7a. Lifetime hunting licenses created for nonresidents;

22	(a) Pursuant to section three of this article, the Director of
23	the Division of Natural Resources may issue lifetime hunting
21	licenses for nonresidents of the state who are sixty-five years of

- 2 lifetime of the licensee. The lifetime hunting license is in lieu
- 3 of the equivalent annual hunting license.
- 4 (b) The director shall propose a rule for legislative approval

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a life-time hunting license for nonresidents who are sixty-five years or older and who own real property in the state. The bill grants the Director of the Division of Natural Resources rule-making authority.
