16	by adding thereto a new section, designated $11-1C-5c$, to read as

18	ARTICLE 1C. FAIR AND EQUITABLE PROPERTY VALUATION.
19	§11-1C-5c. Antique motor vehicle valuation for purposes of
20	personal property tax.
21	Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary,
22	antique motor vehicles shall be valued for purposes of ad valorem
23	property taxes at their salvage value, not to exceed \$200. An
24	"antique motor vehicle" means any motor vehicle which is more than
25	twenty-five years old.

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NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish the value of antique motor vehicles for purposes of personal property taxes.
