- 2 president or designee in the performance of his or her duties
- 3 including, but not limited to: (1) Assistance to members; (2)
- 4 business of the association; and (3) attendance at meetings and

- 7 (b) When the president of the association or his or her
- 8 designee uses the donated annual leave he or she is considered on
- 9 personal annual leave of absence with pay just as if he or she used

- 12 deductions and employee status are maintained as if he or she had
- 13 used his or her regularly accrued annual leave.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for a leave donation program to allow members of the state Trooper's Association to donate accumulated leave time to the president and designee of the president of the state Trooper's Association.
