23	determined by the Bureau of Census of the United States Department

- 1 of Commerce in the taking of the 2000 census of population, shall
- 2 receive an annual housing allowance supplement determined according
- 3 to the following schedule:

- The payments shall be made in equal monthly installments and
- 14 shall be considered a part of the state minimum salaries for
- 15 members of the State Police.
