22	The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
23	thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the

25	this code, modified by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to

meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the state register on the eighteenth day of October, two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists (procedures, criteria and curricula for examinations and licensure of barbers, cosmetologists, manicurists and estheticians, 3 CSR 1), is authorized.
