10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule
13 relating to the organization and operation and licensing of
14 veterinarians.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Veterinary Medicine.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 twenty-seventh day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section six, article ten, chapter thirty, of this
24 code, modified by the West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
25 authorizing the Board of Veterinary Medicine to meet the objections

1 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the
2 state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand
3 ten, relating to the West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
4 the Board of Veterinary Medicine (organization and operation and
5 licensing of veterinarians, 26 CSR 1), is authorized.

7 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
8 Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
9 the Organization and Operation and Licensing of Veterinarians.
