17	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
18	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
19	by adding thereto a new section, designated §60A-3-309, to read as
20	follows:
21	ARTICLE 3. REGULATION OF MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION AND DISPENSING
22	OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.
23	§60A-3-309. Dispensing and delivery of controlled substances by

1mail or delivery service; identification and2signature.3In addition to all other requirements of this chapter, a4controlled substance included in schedules II, III, IV and V, as5described and defined in article two of this chapter may be6dispensed by United States mail or delivery service only if the7person accepting delivery of the controlled substance is eighteen8years of age or older, presents government issued identification9sufficient to identify himself or herself to the person delivering10the controlled substance and signs a receipt indicating his or her11acceptance of delivery of the controlled substance.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that when a controlled substance is dispensed by mail or delivery service, the person accepting delivery of the controlled substance must be eighteen years of age or older, must present government issued identification, and must sign a receipt indicating acceptance of the controlled substance.
