10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule  
13 relating to fees for athletic trainers.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**  
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Physical Therapy.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the  
21 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the  
22 authority of section four, article twenty-a, chapter thirty, of  
23 this code, modified by the Board of Physical Therapy to meet the  
24 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and

1 refiled in the state register on the twentieth day of September,  
2 two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Physical Therapy (fees  
3 for athletic trainers, 16 CSR 6), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Fees for Athletic Trainers.
