20	The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
21	twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the

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1 this code, modified by the State Tax Department to meet the 2 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and 3 refiled in the state register on the fifth day of November, two 4 thousand ten, relating to the State Tax Department (commercial 5 patent incentives tax credit, 110 CSR 13Q), is authorized.

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NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to combined returns pursuant to the Commercial Patent Incentives Tax Credit.
