- 10 certification for stroke care that:

- 15 (C) Uses an organized approach to measure performance.
- 16 (b) The Secretary of the Department of Health and Human
- 17 Resources shall designate as a primary stroke center any acute care
- 18 hospital which has received a primary stroke center certification.
- 19 (c) The secretary shall suspend or revoke an acute care
- 20 hospital's designation as a primary stroke center if certification
- 21 is withdrawn by JCAHO or another approved certifying organization.
