18	Each trapper shall present each <del>Castor canadensis</del> beaver <u>and</u>
19	river otter, or its each pelt, to a game checking station or
20	representative of the division within thirty days after the close
21	of a legal season. A tag provided by the division shall be affixed
22	to each Castor canadensis beaver and river otter, or each pelt and
23	remain attached to the <u>animal or</u> pelt until it is processed into
24	commercial fur.
