10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new section, designated \$15-2-25c, relating
12	to allowing retired officers to carry a concealed weapon in
13	accordance with federal law.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
16	by adding thereto a new section, designated \$15-2-25c, to read as
17	follows:
18	ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.
19	§15-2-25c. Rules generally; retired qualified law-enforcement
20	officers carrying concealed weapons upon
21	retirement.
22	(a) For purposes of this section, unless the context otherwise
23	indicates:
24	(1) "Qualified law-enforcement officer" means an employee of
25	a government agency who:
26	(A) Is authorized by law to engage in or supervise the

- 1 prevention, detection, investigation or prosecution of, or the
- 2 incarceration of any person for, any violation of law and has
- 3 statutory powers of arrest;
- 4 (B) Is authorized by the agency to carry a firearm;
- 5 (C) Is not the subject of any disciplinary action by the 6 agency;
- 7 (D) Meets standards, if any, established by the agency which
- 8 require the employee to regularly qualify in the use of a firearm;
- 9 and
- 10 (E) Is not prohibited by federal law from receiving a firearm.
- 11 (2) "Firearm" does not include any machine gun, any firearm
- 12 silencer and destructive device as defined in the Federal "Law
- 13 Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004."
- 14 (b) Qualified law-enforcement officers shall be permitted to
- 15 carry firearms and weapons and no license may be required for the
- 16 privilege.
- 17 (c) Any qualified law-enforcement officer who is eliqible for
- 18 retirement with at least twenty years of service who has resigned
- 19 in good standing from such law-enforcement agency or board is
- 20 authorized by state law to carry a concealed firearm that has been
- 21 shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce pursuant
- 22 to the federal Law-Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004.
- 23 (d) The Superintendent of the West Virginia State Police will
- 24 create a "Retired Carry Course" that qualified law-enforcement
- 25 officers are required to take every year for a fee of \$25 to
- 26 receive a valid ID to carry a concealed firearm in accordance with

## 1 federal law.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow retired officers to carry a concealed weapon after in accordance with federal law.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
