14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That $\$31-15C-3$ and $\$31-15C-14$ of the Code of West Virginia,
16	1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 15C. Broadband Deployment.
18	§31-15C-3. Broadband Deployment Council established; members of
19	council; administrative support.
20	(a) The Broadband Deployment Council is hereby established.
21	<pre>continued. The council is a governmental instrumentality of the</pre>
22	state. The exercise by the council of the powers conferred by this
23	article and the carrying out of its purpose and duties shall be are
24	considered and held to be, and are hereby determined to be,

- 1 essential governmental functions and for a public purpose. The
- 2 council is created under the Department of Commerce for
- 3 administrative, personnel and technical support services only.
- 4 (b) The council shall consist of eleven voting members,
- 5 designated as follows:
- 6 (1) The Governor or his or her designee;
- 7 (2) The Secretary of Commerce or his or her designee;
- 8 (3) The Secretary of Administration or his or her designee;
- 9 (4) The Director of Homeland Security and Emergency Management
- 10 or his or her designee; and
- 11 (5) Seven public members that serve at the will and pleasure
- 12 of the Governor and are appointed by the Governor with the advice
- 13 and consent of the Senate, as follows:
- 14 (i) One member representing employees of communications and
- 15 cable providers who shall be is a member or representative of a
- 16 union representing communications workers;
- 17 (ii) One member representing telecommunications providers who
- 18 provide broadband services in this state;
- 19 (iii) One member representing cable operators who provide
- 20 broadband services in this state;
- 21 (iv) One member representing broadband equipment or device
- 22 manufacturers;
- 23 (v) One member representing higher education or secondary
- 24 education; and

- 1 (vi) Two members representing the general public who are
  2 residents of the state, *Provided*, That one member represent rural
  3 communities: *Provided*, *however*, That both members may not reside
  4 in the same congressional district. one of whom shall represent
  5 rural communities, and who may not reside in the same congressional
  6 district.
- 7 (6) In addition to the eleven voting members of the council,
  8 the President of the Senate shall name two senators from the West
  9 Virginia Senate and the Speaker of the House shall name two
  10 delegates from the West Virginia House of Delegates, each to serve
  11 in the capacity of an ex officio, nonvoting advisory member of the
  12 council.
- (c) The Secretary of Commerce or his or her designee shall that the council and appoint one of the other council members to serve as vice chair. In the absence of the Secretary of Commerce or his or her designee, the vice chair shall serve as chair. The council shall appoint a secretary-treasurer who need not be a member of the council and who, among other tasks or functions designated by the council, shall keep records of its proceedings.
- 20 (d) The council may appoint committees or subcommittees to 21 investigate and make recommendations to the full council. Members 22 of these committees or subcommittees need not be members of the 23 council.
- (e) Six voting members of the council shall constitute

- 1 <u>constitutes</u> a quorum and the affirmative vote of at least the 2 majority of those members present <del>shall be</del> <u>is</u> necessary for any 3 action taken by vote of the council.
- (f) The council is part-time. Public members appointed by the 5 Governor may pursue and engage in another business or occupation or 6 gainful employment. Any person employed by, owning an interest in 7 or otherwise associated with a broadband deployment project, 8 project sponsor or project participant may serve as a council 9 member and shall not be is not disqualified from serving as a 10 council member because of a conflict of interest prohibited under 11 section five, article two, chapter six-b of this code and shall not 12 be is not subject to prosecution for violation of said section when 13 the violation is created solely as a result of his or her 14 relationship with the broadband deployment project, project sponsor 15 or project participant Provided, That so long as the member recuses 16 himself or herself from board participation regarding the 17 conflicting issue in the manner set forth in legislative rules 18 promulgated by the West Virginia Ethics Commission.
- (g) No member of the council who serves by virtue of his or her office shall receive receives any compensation or reimbursement of expenses for serving as a member. The public members and members of any committees or subcommittees are entitled to be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred for each day or portion thereof engaged in the discharge of his or her official

- 1 duties in a manner consistent with the guidelines of the Travel
- 2 Management Office of the Department of Administration.
- 3 §31-15C-14. Expiration of council.
- The council shall continue to exist until December 31, 2011,
- 5 2014, unless sooner terminated, continued or reestablished pursuant
- 6 to an act of the Legislature.
