- The term "presiding officer" or "presiding officers" when used in the constitution, this code, joint rule or rule of the body to refer to the presiding officers of the Legislature include any member authorized by the respective body, by rule or otherwise, to act in the place of the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Delegates.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that references in the constitution, the code, joint rule, or rule of the body to the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Delegates, or presiding officer, include any member authorized by the respective body, by rule or otherwise, to act in the place of the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Delegates.
