10	A BILL to amend $\$30-4-17$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
11	amended, relating to activities that may be performed by a
12	dental hygienist without a prior exam by a dentist.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That §30-4-17 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
15	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 4. WEST VIRGINIA DENTAL PRACTICE ACT.
17	<pre>\$30-4-17. Scope of practice; dental hygienist.</pre>
18	The practice of dental hygiene includes the following:
19	(1) Performing a complete prophylaxis, including the removal
20	of any deposit, accretion or stain from the surface of a tooth or
21	a restoration;
22	(2) Applying a medicinal agent to a tooth for a prophylactic
23	purpose;
24	(3) Taking a dental X-ray;
25	(4) Instructing a patient on proper oral hygiene practice;
26	(5) Placing sealants on a patient's teeth without a prior

1 examination by a licensed dentist: Provided, That for this
2 subdivision, the dental hygienist has a Public Health Practice
3 permit issued by the West Virginia Board of Dental Examiners, and
4 under a collaborative agreement with a supervising dentist and the
5 patient is referred for a dental examination within six months of
6 sealant application.

7 (5) (6) Performing all delegated procedures of a dental 8 hygienist specified by rule by the board; and

9 (6) (7) Performing all delegated procedures of a dental 10 assistant specified by rule by the board.
