10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$33-6-34$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to increasing the filing fees for
12	insurers; permitting multiple insurers to make a single filing
13	with a fee collected from each one; defining a term; and
14	deleting an effective date.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §33-6-34 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 6. THE INSURANCE POLICY.
19	§33-6-34. Fee for form, rate and rule filing.
20	(a) As used in this section, "filing" means any form filing
21	made pursuant to section eight of this article or any rule or rate
22	filing made in accordance with any rate filing provisions of this
23	chapter.

(a) (b) A fee of \$50 for every form filing and \$75 for every 1 2 rate or rule filing \$125 shall be submitted with each filing for 3 each company. If a form filing or rate or rule filing is made on 4 behalf of more than one insurer, other than a filing made by a 5 rating organization licensed by the commissioner, pursuant to 6 section six, article twenty of this chapter, the applicable fee 7 shall be submitted as if the filing were made by each individual 8 insurer \$125 multiplied by the number of insurers on whose behalf 9 the filing is made. Fees submitted pursuant to this section shall 10 not be refunded if the form filing or rate or rule filing, for 11 which the fee was submitted, is disapproved, in whole or in part, 12 by the commissioner. The refiling and a resubmission of a form 13 filing or rate or rule filing previously disapproved by the 14 commissioner shall be considered a new filing for the purposes of 15 the filing fee. *Provided*, That any Any request by the commissioner 16 for additional information pertaining to a form filing shall not be 17 considered a new filing for purposes of the filing fee. All fees 18 collected pursuant to this section shall be used by the 19 commissioner for the operation of the division offices of the 20 Insurance Commissioner. 21 (b) This section as amended in the year 2002 applies to 22 filings submitted after June 30, 2002. When there is a refiling 23 after that date of a filing denied before July 1, 2002, the new 24 filing fee structure applies and the fee shall be remitted when the

1 form, rate or rule is refiled after June 30, 2002.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the filing fees for insurers to \$125. The bill permits multiple insurers to make a single filing with the \$125 fee collected from each one. The bill defines a term and deletes an effective date.
