This one-time supplement shall equal two percent 6 of his or her monthly annuity benefit. 7 (b) A one-time supplement to retirement benefits is provided 8 to all retirees that have been annuitants for at least five or more 9 consecutive years as of the effective date of this section and 10 beneficiaries of deceased members who have been annuitants for at 11 least five or more consecutive years as of the effective date of 12 this section.
