15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated \$19-1-11, to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 1. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.
20	§19-1-11. Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program Fund.
21	(a) The Legislature finds and declares that:
22	(1) The West Virginia Department of Agriculture has
23	participated in the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program since
2 /1	the program's incention in 2001 and competes with other states for

- 1 federal grant funding. The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition
- 2 Program currently provides vouchers to eligible seniors to purchase
- 3 produce at farmers markets around the state.
- 4 (2) The voucher is beneficial to both the seniors who receive
- 5 the health benefits of additional produce in their diets and local
- 6 farmers benefit from the additional moneys being used to purchase
- 7 produce at local farmers' markets.
- 8 (3) According to the Center for Disease Control, healthy diets
- 9 rich in fruits and vegetables may reduce the risk of cancer and
- 10 other chronic diseases. Fruits and vegetables also provide
- 11 essential vitamins and minerals, fiber, and other substances that
- 12 are important for good health.
- 13 (4) In 2010, twenty-three thousand seven hundred fifty
- 14 <u>eligible seniors received \$20 in vouchers.</u>
- 15 (5) The state should consider adding \$30 to the amount of the
- 16 current voucher.
- 17 (b) There is created a "Seniors Farmers' Market Nutrition
- 18 Program Fund" with the specific purpose of supplementing the
- 19 federal funds received for the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition
- 20 Program.
- 21 (c) Moneys in the "Seniors Farmers' Market Nutrition Program
- 22 Fund" at the close of the fiscal year remains in the "Seniors
- 23 Farmers' Market Nutrition Program Fund" and do not lapse to the
- 24 general revenue.

- 1 (d) It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this
- 2 section to create a fund subject to general revenue appropriation
- 3 to provide for additional moneys to be used for the Senior Farmers'
- 4 Market Nutrition Program.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to develop a Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program Fund within the Department of Agriculture.
