21	§8-12-18a. Conveyance of property to a nonprofit.
22	(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section eighteen of this
23	article, a municipality may lease or convey city property to
24	nonprofit organizations for less than fair market value, and

- 1 without public auction if the city council has made a factual
- 2 determination that:
- 3 (1) There is a lack of need for the property by the city in
- 4 comparison to the benefit to the city if property is leased or
- 5 conveyed; and
- 6 (2) There is a demonstrable need for the property by the
- 7 nonprofit organization to be able to perform the services it
- 8 provides in benefitting the public.
- 9 (b) If the nonprofit organization should cease to provide
- 10 those services to the public, the property shall by operation of
- 11 law, revert to and vest in the city, and after that the nonprofit
- 12 organization has no right, title or interest in or to the property.
- 13 (c) Any lease, deed or other instrument of transferring the
- 14 property executed pursuant to this section shall contain the
- 15 reversion wording contained in subsection (b) of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit a municipality to convey property to a nonprofit for a specific public interest that benefits the municipality.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
