NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to extend the statute of limitations, to file a civil action for a claim of sexual abuse against a minor causing psychological injury or illness, to within three years after plaintiff discovers or reasonably should have discovered the psychological injury or illness, after reaching the age of majority.
