11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing to promulgate a
14 legislative rule relating to the establishment of required
15 qualifications and ethical standards for interpreters and
16 transliterators.

17 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

18 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
19 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

20 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
21 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

22 **§64-9-1. Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing.**

23 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the first
24 day of August, two thousand eleven, authorized under the authority

1 of section five, article fourteen-a, chapter five, of this code,
2 modified by the Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing to meet
3 the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
4 refiled in the State Register on the first day of December, two
5 thousand eleven, relating to the Commission for the Deaf and Hard
6 of Hearing (establishment of required qualifications and ethical
7 standards for interpreters and transliterators, [192 CSR 3](#)), is
8 authorized.

10 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commission
11 for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing to promulgate a legislative rule
12 relating to the Establishment of Required Qualifications and
13 Ethical Standards for Interpreters and Translitterators.
