20	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21	twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the
22	authority of section four, article one, chapter sixteen, of this

code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to
meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee
and refiled in the State Register on the first day of December, two
thousand eleven, relating to the Department of Health and Human
Resources (manufactured home communities, 64 CSR 40), is
authorized.
