22	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the

twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the authority of section five-s, article ten, chapter eleven, of this code, modified by the State Tax Department to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on the twenty-second day of November, two thousand eleven, relating to the State Tax Department (exchange of information agreement between the State Tax Department and the Department of Commerce, the Department of Transportation and the Department of Environmental Protection, 110 CSR 50G), is authorized.
