L 8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
L 9	That §5A-3-52 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
20	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
21	ARTICLE 3. PURCHASING DIVISION.
22	§5A-3-52. Special funds for travel management created.
23	(a) The travel management special fund is terminated. All
24	deposits currently in this special fund from aviation fees shall be

transferred into the Aviation Fund. All funds in this special fund

- 1 from the monthly fee for vehicles shall be transferred into the 2 Fleet Management Office Fund.
- (b) There is created in the State Treasury a special revenue

 4 account, to be known as the "Fleet Management Office Fund".

 5 Expenditures are authorized from collections but are to be made

 6 only in accordance with appropriation by the Legislature and in

 7 accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twelve of

 8 this code and upon fulfillment of the provisions of article two,

 9 chapter eleven-b of this code. Any balance remaining in the special

 10 revenue account at the end of any state fiscal year does not revert

 11 to the General Revenue Fund but remains in the special revenue
