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7		FISCAL NOTE
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10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$29-6-27$ of the Code of West Virginia,	
11	1931, as amended, relating to permitting a civil service	
12	employee to donate annual leave to another employee; removing	
13	the medical emergency requirement; modifying a definition; and	
14	authorizing rulemaking.	
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
16	That §29-6-27 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,	
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:	
18	ARTICLE 6. CIVIL SERVICE SYSTEM.	
19	§29-6-27. Leave donation program.	
20	The Division of Personnel after consultation with other state	
21	agencies shall establish a program under which annual leave accrued	
22	or accumulated by an employee of an agency may, if voluntarily	
23	agreed to by the employee, be transferred to the annual leave	

1 account of another designated employee if the other employee
2 requires additional leave because of a medical emergency.

3 <u>(a) The Division of Personnel's leave donation program is</u> 4 <u>continued. State employees may donate annual leave to a fellow</u> 5 <u>state employee who has exhausted</u>, or will exhaust, all types of 6 paid leave.

7 (b) The division shall establish the annual leave program 8 shall be established by legislative rule pursuant to the provisions 9 of chapter twenty-nine-a of this code. The Division of Personnel 10 shall file such legislative rule no later than July 15, 1995.

11 (c) The division shall prepare an annual status report to be 12 presented to the Joint Committee on Government and Finance no later 13 than January 5, each year. A "medical emergency" means a medical 14 condition of an employee or a family member of the employee that is 15 likely to require the prolonged absence of the employee from duty 16 and which will result in a substantial loss of income to the 17 employee because of the unavailability of paid leave. As used in 18 this section,

19 (d) No leave transferred may be used to qualify for or add to 20 service for any retirement system administered by the State of West 21 <u>Virginia.</u>

22 <u>(e) For the purposes of this section</u> "employee" includes 23 employees <u>means a person</u> in the classified and classified-exempt

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1 service and employees <u>a person</u> exempt from coverage who are under 2 this article entitled to annual leave as a benefit of employment. 3 *Provided*, That none of the leave so transferred may be used to 4 qualify for or add to service for any retirement system 5 administered by the State of West Virginia.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit a civil service employee to donate annual leave to another employee. The bill removes the medical emergency requirement before leave can be transferred. The bill also modifies a definition and provides rule-making authority.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
