A BILL to amend and reenact $\$18-2-25$ of the Code of West Virginia,
1931, as amended, relating to the secondary schools athletic
commission; and participation by home schooled students in
extracurricular activities.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
That §18-2-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.
\$18-2-25. Authority of county boards to regulate athletic and
other extracurricular activities of secondary schools;
delegation of authority to West Virginia Secondary
School Activities Commission; authority of commission;
approval of rules and regulations by state board;
incorporation; funds; participation by private and
parochial schools and by home schooled students.
The county boards of education are hereby granted and shall

1 exercise the control, supervision and regulation of all 2 interscholastic athletic events, and other extracurricular 3 activities of the students in public secondary schools, and of said 4 <u>those</u> schools of their respective counties. The county board of 5 education may delegate such <u>that</u> control, supervision and 6 regulation of interscholastic athletic events and band activities 7 to the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission. which

8 is hereby established

The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall 9 10 be is composed of the principals, or their representatives, of 11 those secondary schools whose county boards of education have 12 certified in writing to the State Superintendent of Schools that 13 they have elected to delegate the control, supervision and 14 regulation of their interscholastic athletic events and band 15 activities of the students in the public secondary schools in their 16 respective counties to said the commission. The West Virginia 17 Secondary School Activities Commission is hereby empowered to 18 exercise the control, supervision and regulation of interscholastic 19 athletic events and band activities of secondary schools, delegated 20 to it pursuant to this section. The rules and regulations of the 21 West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall contain 22 a provision for a proper review procedure and review board and be 23 promulgated in accordance with the provisions of chapter 24 twenty-nine-a of this code, but shall are, in all instances be

1 subject to the prior approval of the state board. The West 2 Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, may, with the 3 consent of the State Board of Education, incorporate under the name 4 of "West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, Inc.," as 5 a nonprofit, nonstock corporation under the provisions of chapter 6 thirty-one of this code. County boards of education are hereby 7 authorized to may expend moneys for and pay dues to the West 8 Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, and all moneys 9 paid to such the commission, as well as moneys derived from any 10 contest or other event sponsored by said the commission, shall be 11 <u>are</u> quasi-public funds as the same are defined in article five, 12 chapter eighteen, and such the funds of the commission shall be <u>are</u> 13 subject to an annual audit by the State Tax Commissioner.

The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall promulgate reasonable rules and regulations providing for the control, supervision and regulation of the interscholastic athletic events and other extracurricular activities of such private and parochial secondary schools as that elect to delegate to such the commission such control, supervision and regulation, upon the same commission such control, subject to the same regulations and requirements and upon the payment of the same fees and charges as those provided for public secondary schools. Any such private or parochial secondary school shall receive any monetary or other the same proportion as any

1 public secondary school.

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or the 3 commission's rules, the commission shall consider eligible for 4 participation in extracurricular activities of secondary schools a 5 student who is receiving home instruction pursuant to subsection 6 (c), section one, article eight of chapter eighteen of this code 7 and who: 8 (1) Has demonstrated satisfactory evidence of academic 9 progress for two years in compliance with the provisions of that 10 subsection; (2) Has not reached the age of nineteen by August 1 of the 11 12 current school year; (3) Is an amateur who receives no compensation, but 13 14 participates solely for the educational, physical, mental and 15 social benefits of the activity; 16 (4) Agrees to comply with all disciplinary rules applicable to 17 all other athletes and activity participants; and (5) Agrees to obey all rules of the West Virginia Secondary 18 19 Schools Activities Commission governing awards, all-star games, 20 parental consents, and physical examinations applicable to all high 21 school athletes. 22 Eligibility is limited to participation in interscholastic 23 programs at the public secondary school serving the attendance zone

24 in which the student lives. Reasonable fees may be charged to the

1 student to cover the costs of participation in interscholastic programs.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow for the participation of home schooled students in certain secondary school activities.
