22	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
23	fifteenth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the
24	authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two, of

- 2 (permits for construction and major modification of major
- 3 stationary sources for the prevention of significant deterioration
- 4 of air quality, 45 CSR 14), is authorized.
