20	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the

23	seven, of this code, modified by the Division of Labor to meet the

objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and

- 1 refiled in the State Register on the twenty-first day of December,
- 2 two thousand twelve, relating to the Division of Labor (bedding and
- 3 upholstered furniture, <u>42 CSR 12</u>), is authorized.
