20	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21	thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
22	the authority of section three, article two-d, chapter fifteen of
23	this code, modified by the Division of Protective Services to meet
24	the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
25	refiled in the State Register on the seventeenth day of January,
26	two thousand thirteen, relating to the Division of Protective

Services (contracted police or security services, <u>99 CSR 5</u>), is
authorized.
