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10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$8-14-7$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to policemen's civil service
12	commissions; authorizing commissioners to serve on other
13	boards and commissions.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That §8-14-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 14. LAW AND ORDER; POLICE FORCE OR DEPARTMENTS; POWERS,
18	AUTHORITY AND DUTIES OF LAW-ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS
19	AND POLICEMEN; POLICE MATRONS; SPECIAL SCHOOL ZONE
20	AND PARKING LOT OR PARKING BUILDING POLICE
21	OFFICERS; CIVIL SERVICE FOR CERTAIN POLICE
22	DEPARTMENTS.
23	§8-14-7. Policemen's civil service commission generally.
24	In every Class I and Class II city having a paid police
25	department, there shall be a "Policemen's Civil Service
26	Commission." The commission shall consist of three commissioners,
27	one of whom shall be appointed by the mayor of the city; one of

1 whom shall be appointed by the local fraternal order of police; and 2 the third shall be appointed by the local chamber of commerce, or 3 if there be is none, by a local businessmen's association. The 4 individuals appointed commissioners shall be qualified voters of 5 the city for which they are appointed; and at least two of said the 6 commissioners shall be individuals in full sympathy with the 7 purposes of the civil service provisions of this article. Not more 8 than two of the said commissioners, at any one time, shall may be 9 adherents of the same political party. Of the three original 10 appointments in each city, the first commissioner shall be 11 appointed by the mayor and shall serve for six years from the date 12 of his or her appointment; the second commissioner shall be 13 appointed by the local fraternal order of police and shall serve 14 for four years from the date of his or her appointment; and the 15 third commissioner shall be appointed by the local chamber of 16 commerce or local businessmen's association and shall serve for two 17 years from the date of his or her appointment. In the event there 18 is no local chamber of commerce or local businessmen's association 19 at the time any appointment is to be made by it, such the 20 appointment shall be made by the other two commissioners by mutual 21 agreement. After the original appointments, all appointments shall 22 be made for periods of four years each by the appointing authority 23 hereinbefore designated. In the event that any commissioner of 24 said the civil service commission shall cease ceases to be a member 25 thereof of the commission by virtue of death, final removal or 26 other cause, a new commissioner shall be appointed to fill the

1 unexpired term of said the commissioner within ten days after said 2 the excommissioner shall have has ceased to be a member of said the 3 commission. Such The appointment shall be made by the officer or 4 body who in the first instance appointed the commissioner who is no 5 longer a member of the commission, except that in the case of a 6 vacancy in an appointment made by the Governor, which vacancy 7 occurs after the effective date of this article, the appointment 8 for the unexpired term shall be made by the mayor. Each year the 9 three members of the commission shall, together, elect one of their 10 number to act as president of the commission, who shall serve 11 serves as president for one year. The mayor may, at any time, 12 remove any commissioner or commissioners for good cause, which 13 shall be stated in writing and made a part of the records of the 14 commission: Provided, That once the mayor has removed any 15 commissioner, the mayor shall within ten days thereafter file in 16 the office of the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which 17 the city or the major portion of the territory thereof is located 18 a petition setting forth in full the reason for said the removal 19 and praying for the confirmation by said the circuit court of the 20 action of the mayor in so removing the said commissioner. A copy 21 of said the petition shall be served upon the commissioner so 22 removed simultaneously with its filing in the office of the clerk 23 of the circuit court and shall have has precedence on the docket of 24 said the court and shall be heard by said the court as soon as 25 practicable upon the request of the removed commissioner or 26 commissioners. All rights herein vested in said the circuit court

1 by this section may be exercised by the judge thereof in vacation. 2 In the event that no term of the circuit court is being held at the 3 time of the filing of said the petition, and the judge thereof 4 cannot be reached in the county wherein in which the petition was 5 filed, said the petition shall be heard at the next succeeding term 6 of said the circuit court, whether regular or special, and the 7 commissioner or commissioners so removed shall remain remains 8 removed until a hearing is had upon the said the petition of the 9 mayor. The court or the judge thereof in vacation shall hear and 10 decide the issues presented by said the petition. The mayor or 11 commissioner or commissioners, as the case may be, against whom the 12 decision of the court or the judge thereof in vacation shall be is 13 rendered, shall have has the right to petition the Supreme Court of 14 Appeals for a review of the decision of the circuit court or the 15 judge thereof in vacation as in other civil cases. In the event 16 that If the mayor shall fail fails to file his a petition in the 17 office of the clerk of the circuit court as hereinbefore provided 18 within ten days after the removal of said the commissioner or 19 commissioners, such the commissioner or commissioners shall 20 immediately resume his or her or their position or positions as a 21 member or members of the policemen's civil service commission.

Any resident of the city shall have <u>has</u> the right at any time Any resident of the city shall have <u>has</u> the right at any time to file charges against and seek the removal of any member of the policemen's civil service commission of <u>such the</u> city. <u>Such The</u> charges shall be filed in the form of a petition in the office of the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the city or

1 the major portion of the territory thereof of the city is located, 2 and a copy of said the petition shall be served upon the 3 commissioner or commissioners sought to be removed. Said The 4 petition shall be matured for hearing and heard by said the circuit 5 court or the judge thereof in vacation in the same manner as civil 6 proceedings in the circuit courts of this state are heard, and the 7 party against whom the circuit court's decision is rendered shall 8 have has the right to petition the Supreme Court of Appeals for a 9 review of the action of the circuit court, as in other civil cases. 10 No commissioner shall hold any other office (other than the 11 office of notary public) under the United States, this state, or 12 any municipality, county or other political subdivision thereof; 13 nor shall any commissioner serve on any political committee or take 14 any active part in the management of any political campaign.

A commissioner may not hold another office under the United States, this state, or any municipality, county or other political subdivision thereof, nor may a commissioner serve on a political committee or take an active part in the management of a political gampaign, except that a commissioner may serve as a notary public or on another local, regional or state board or commission in a

21 part-time capacity.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow members of a policemen's civil service commission to serve on other local boards and commissions outside of the policemen's civil service commission.
