21	<u>§11-1-1b. The Economic Fairness Act of 2013.</u>	
22	(a) The Tax Commissioner shall designate the five counties	
23	with the highest average unemployment during the previous three	

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1 years and refund to those counties twenty percent of their personal 2 income tax collections from the previous year: Provided, That the 3 maximum refund to one county may not exceed \$500,000. 4 (b) The refunds provided in subsection (a) of this section 5 shall be paid to the general fund of the counties with the specific 6 designation that the refunds be used for projects defined in 7 section four, article fifteen of chapter thirty-one. 8 (c) Each of the counties so designated shall submit to the 9 West Virginia Economic Development Authority an economic 10 development plan which must first be approved by the authority 11 before the refunds are released to the counties.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create the economic fairness act and encourage economic development in counties with high unemployment.
