23	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
24	thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under

the authority of section one, article eleven, chapter sixteen, of
this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources
to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
Committee and refiled in the State Register on the fifth day of
February, two thousand thirteen, relating to the Department of
Health and Human Resources (regulation of opioid treatment
programs, 69 CSR 7), is authorized.
