Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.
§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the Department of
Education and West Virginia Racing Commission to be moral
obligations of the state and directing payments thereof.
The Legislature has heretofore made findings of fact that the
state has received the benefit of the commodities received and/or
services rendered by certain claimants herein and has considered
these claims against the state, and agencies thereof, which have

1 arisen due to overexpenditures of the departmental appropriations 2 by officers of the state spending units, the claims having been 3 previously considered by the Court of Claims which also found that 4 the state has received the benefit of the commodities received 5 and/or services rendered by the claimants, but were denied by the 6 Court of Claims on the purely statutory grounds that to allow the 7 claims would be condoning illegal acts contrary to the laws of the 8 state. The Legislature, pursuant to its findings of fact and also 9 by the adoption of the findings of fact by the Court of Claims as 10 its own, while not condoning such illegal acts, hereby declares it 11 to be the moral obligation of the state to pay these claims in the 12 amounts specified below and directs the Auditor to issue warrants 13 upon receipt of properly executed requisitions supported by 14 itemized invoices, statements or other satisfactory documents as 15 required by section ten, article three, chapter twelve of the Code 16 of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, for the payments thereof out of 17 any fund appropriated and available for the purpose.
