18	(a) Each department shall make a presentation pursuant to the

21	session of the year in which the department is to be reviewed
22	pursuant to the schedule set forth in subsection (b) of this
23	section.

- 1 (b) An agency review shall be performed on one or more
- 2 agencies under the purview of each department at least once every
- 3 six eight years, commencing as follows:
- 4 (1) 2008, the Department of Administration;
- 5 (2) 2009, the Department of Education and the Arts, and the
- 6 Department of Education, including the Higher Education Policy
- 7 Commission and the West Virginia Council for Community and
- 8 Technical College Education;
- 9 (3) 2010, the Department of Revenue and the Department of
- 10 Commerce;
- 11 (4) 2011, the Department of Environmental Protection and the
- 12 Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety;
- 13 (5) 2012, the Department of Health and Human Resources,
- 14 including the Bureau of Senior Services;
- (6) (1) 2013, the Department of Transportation; and
- 16 (2) 2014, the Department of Administration;

- 18 Education Policy Commission and the West Virginia Council for
