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11	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$15-2-7$ of the Code of West Virginia,
12	1931, as amended, relating to the State Police; and providing
13	civilian employee pay increase.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That $\$15-2-7$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.
18	$\S15-2-7$. Cadet selection board; qualifications for and appointment
19	to membership in State Police; civilian employees.
20	(a) The superintendent shall establish within the West
21	Virginia State Police a cadet selection board which shall be
22	representative of commissioned and noncommissioned officers within

- 1 the State Police.
- 2 (b) The superintendent shall appoint a member to the position
- 3 of trooper from among the top three names on the current list of
- 4 eligible applicants established by the cadet selection board.
- 5 (c) Preference in making appointments shall be given whenever
- 6 possible to honorably discharged members of the Armed Forces of the
- 7 United States and to residents of West Virginia. Each applicant
- 8 for appointment shall be a person not less than twenty-one years of
- 9 age nor more than thirty-nine years of age, of sound Constitution
- 10 and good moral character; is required to pass any mental and
- 11 physical examination; and meet other requirements as provided in
- 12 rules promulgated by the cadet selection board: Provided, That a
- 13 former member may, at the discretion of the superintendent, be
- 14 reenlisted.
- 15 (d) No person may be barred from becoming a member of the
- 16 State Police because of his or her religious or political
- 17 convictions.
- 18 (e) The superintendent shall adhere to the principles of equal
- 19 employment opportunity set forth in article eleven, chapter five of
- 20 this code and shall take positive steps to encourage applications
- 21 for State Police membership from females and minority groups within
- 22 the state. An annual report shall be filed with the Legislature on
- 23 or before January 1 of each year by the superintendent which

- 1 includes a summary of the efforts and the effectiveness of those
- 2 efforts intended to recruit females, African-Americans and other
- 3 minorities into the ranks of the State Police.
- 4 (f) Except for the superintendent, no person may be appointed
- 5 or enlisted to membership in the State Police at a grade or rank
- 6 above the grade of trooper.
- 7 (g) The superintendent shall appoint civilian employees as are
- 8 necessary and all employees may be included in the classified
- 9 service of the civil service system except those in positions
- 10 exempt under the provisions of article six, chapter twenty-nine of
- 11 this code.
- 12 (h) Effective July 1, 2001 <u>2013</u>, civilian employees with a
- 13 minimum of five three years' service shall receive a salary
- 14 increase equal to \$100 \$700 a year for each year of service as a
- 15 civilian employee. Every three years year thereafter, civilian
- 16 employees who have five four or more years of service shall receive
- 17 an annual salary increase of \$300 \$400. The increases in salary
- 18 provided by this subsection are in addition to any other increases
- 19 to which the civilian employees might otherwise be entitled.
- 20 <u>(i) Effective July 1, 2013, State Police forensic lab</u>
- 21 employees with a minimum of one year of service shall receive a
- 22 salary increase equal to \$2,000, after six years of employment the
- 23 State Police forensic lab employee shall receive a salary increase

- 1 equal to \$3,000 and after ten years of employment the State Police
- 2 <u>forensic lab employee shall receive a salary increase equal to</u>
- 3 \$4,000.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase salaries for State Police forensic lab employees.
