The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 3 2013, authorized under the authority of section seven, article 4 thirty-two, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of 5 Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to meet the 6 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and 7 refiled in the State Register on November 26, 2013, relating to the 8 Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology 9 (disciplinary and complaint procedures for speech-language 10 pathology and audiology, 29 CSR 4), is authorized.
