18	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
19	That $\S5F-2-1$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
20	be amended and reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding
21	thereto a new section, designated §5F-2-8, all to read as follows:
22	ARTICLE 2. TRANSFER OF AGENCIES AND BOARDS.

## 1 §5F-2-1. Transfer and incorporation of agencies and boards; funds.

- 22 are not affected by the enactment of this chapter.

- 1 (n) Except for powers, authority and duties that have been 2 delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the provisions 3 of section two of this article, the existence, powers, authority 4 and duties of boards and the membership, terms and qualifications 5 of members of the boards are not affected by the enactment of this 6 chapter. All boards that are appellate bodies or are independent 7 decision makers shall not have their appellate or independent 8 decision-making status affected by the enactment of this chapter.
- 9 (o) Any department previously transferred to and incorporated 10 in a department by prior enactment of this section means a division 11 of the appropriate department. Wherever reference is made to any 12 department transferred to and incorporated in a department created 13 in section two, article one of this chapter, the reference means a 14 division of the appropriate department and any reference to a 15 division of a department so transferred and incorporated means a 16 section of the appropriate division of the department.
- (p) When an agency, board or commission is transferred under a bureau or agency other than a department headed by a secretary pursuant to this section, that transfer is solely for purposes of administrative support and liaison with the Office of the Governor, a department secretary or a bureau. Nothing in this section extends the powers of department secretaries under section two of

- 1 this article to any person other than a department secretary and
- 2 nothing limits or abridges the statutory powers and duties of
- 3 statutory commissioners or officers pursuant to this code.

## 4 §5F-2-8. Transfer of Division of Early Care and Education and the

- 5 Head Start State Collaborative.
- 6 Effective July 1, 2014, the Division of Early Care and
- 7 Education and the Head Start State Collaborative are hereby
- 8 transferred from the Bureau of Children and Families within the
- 9 Department of Health and Human Resources to the Department of
- 10 Education and the Arts. This transfer includes all employees,
- 11 funds, rules, records, responsibilities, obligations, assets and
- 12 property, of whatever kind and character, that are associated with
- 13 the division or collaborative.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to transfer the Division of Early Care and Education and the Head Start State Collaborative from the Bureau of Children and Families within the Department of Health and Human Resources to the Department of Education and the Arts, effective July 1, 2014. The bill also makes a technical correction.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.

\$5F-2-8\$ is new; therefore, underscoring and strike-throughs have been omitted.
