22	(a) A licensed school psychologist means a professional who

- 2 (b) Each county board that provides licensed school
- 3 psychologist services for each pupil enrolled in the public schools
- 4 of the county shall provide by the school year 2015-2016, and
- 5 thereafter, sufficient licensed school psychologist services and
- 6 personnel that will ensure that there is no more than a fifteen
- 7 hundred pupil ratio for each licensed school psychologist in the
- 8 county.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that the maximum licensed school psychologist-pupil ratio is fifteen hundred pupils for each licensed school psychologist.
