21	<pre>§21-3A-2. Definitions.</pre>	
22	As used in this chapter, unless the context clearly indicates	
23	otherwise:	
24	(a) "Commission" means the occupational safety and health

1 review commission established under this article;

2 (b) "Commissioner" means the labor commissioner or his <u>or her</u> 3 designated agent;

4 (c) "Employee" means any public employee of the state, or any
5 state agency;

6 (d) "Employer" means public employer and shall include the 7 state or any department, division, bureau, board, council, agency 8 or authority of the state, but shall <u>does</u> not include the 9 department of corrections, the department of health and <u>or</u> the 10 Legislature;

(e) "Occupational safety and health standard" means a standard for health or safety which requires the adoption or use of one or more practices, means, methods, operations or processes reasonably necessary or appropriate to provide safe and healthful employment in places of employment;

16 (f) "Person" means one or more individuals; and

17 (g) "Workplace" means a place where public employees are 18 assigned to work but shall <u>does</u> not include any place where public 19 employees are assigned to work that is inspected and regulated in 20 accordance with federal occupational safety and health standards or 21 mine safety and health administration standards, or facilities 22 under the authority of the department of corrections, the 23 department of health, or the Legislature.
