10 A BILL to amend and reenact $\$ 17 A-3-14$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue a special license plate for applicants who are deaf or hearing impaired and establishing requirements for eligibility; and fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That $517 A-3-14$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.
§17A-3-14. Registration plates generally; description of plates; issuance of special numbers and plates; registration fees; special application fees; exemptions; commissioner to promulgate forms; suspension and
nonrenewal.

7 (1) Every registration plate shall be of reflectorized 8 material and have displayed upon it the registration number 9 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; the name of this 10 state, which may be abbreviated; and the year number for which it 11 is issued or the date of expiration of the plate.
(2) State officials and judges may be issued special 2 registration plates as follows:
(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 4 the Secretary of State, State Superintendent of Schools, Auditor, 5 Treasurer, Commissioner of Agriculture and the Attorney General,

6 the members of both houses of the Legislature, including the 7 elected officials of both houses of the Legislature, the justices 8 of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, the 9 representatives and senators of the state in the Congress of the 10 United States, the judges of the West Virginia circuit courts, 11 active and retired on senior status, the judges of the United 12 States district courts for the State of West Virginia and the 13 judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the fourth 14 circuit, if any of the judges are residents of West Virginia, a 15 special registration plate for a Class A motor vehicle and a 16 special registration plate for a Class $G$ motorcycle owned by the 17 official or his or her spouse: Provided, That the division may 18 issue a Class A special registration plate for each vehicle titled 19 to the official and a Class $G$ special registration plate for each 20 motorcycle titled to the official.
(B) Each plate issued pursuant to this subdivision shall bear 22 any combination of letters and numbers not to exceed an amount 23 determined by the commissioner and a designation of the office. 24 Each plate shall supersede the regular numbered plate assigned to

1 the official or his or her spouse during the official's term of 2 office and while the motor vehicle is owned by the official or his 3 or her spouse.

4 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of $\$ 15$ for every 5 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision, which is in 6 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

7 (3) The division may issue members of the National Guard 8 forces special registration plates as follows:
(A) Upon receipt of an application on a form prescribed by the 10 division and receipt of written evidence from the chief executive 11 officer of the Army National Guard or Air National Guard, as 12 appropriate, or the commanding officer of any United States Armed 13 Forces reserve unit that the applicant is a member thereof, the 14 division shall issue to any member of the National Guard of this 15 state or a member of any reserve unit of the United States Armed 16 Forces a special registration plate designed by the commissioner 17 for any number of Class A motor vehicles owned by the member. Upon 18 presentation of written evidence of retirement status, retired 19 members of this state's Army or Air National Guard, or retired 20 members of any reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces, are 21 eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued pursuant 22 to this subdivision.
(B) The division shall charge an initial application fee of 24 \$10 for each special registration plate issued pursuant to this

1 subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required by 2 this chapter. Except as otherwise provided herein, effective July 3 1, 2007, all fees currently held in the special revolving fund used 4 in the administration of this section and all fees collected by the 5 division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

6 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 7 spouse's National Guard forces license plate until the surviving 8 spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

9 (4) Specially arranged registration plates may be issued as
(A) Upon appropriate application, any owner of a motor vehicle 12 subject to Class A registration, or a motorcycle subject to Class 13 G registration, as defined by this article, may request that the 14 division issue a registration plate bearing specially arranged 15 letters or numbers with the maximum number of letters or numbers to 16 be determined by the commissioner. The division shall attempt to 17 comply with the request wherever possible.

18 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative 19 approval in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a 20 of this code regarding the orderly distribution of the plates:
(C) An annual fee of $\$ 15$ shall be charged for each special

1 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision, which is in 2 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

3 (5) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans 4 special registration plates as follows:

5 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to 6 any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed 7 services of the United States a special registration plate for any 8 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant 9 with an insignia designed by the Commissioner of the Division of 10 Motor Vehicles.
(B) The division shall charge a special initial application 12 fee of $\$ 10$ in addition to all other fees required by law. This 13 special fee is to compensate the Division of Motor Vehicles for 14 additional costs and services required in the issuing of the 15 special registration. All fees collected by the division shall be 16 deposited in the State Road Fund: Provided, That nothing in this 17 section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any other

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2 any disabled veteran who is exempt from the payment of registration
3 fees under the provisions of this chapter a registration plate for 4 a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant which bears 5 the letters "DV" in red and also the regular identification 6 numerals in red.

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(B) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 8 spouse's disabled veterans license plate until the surviving spouse 9 dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.

10 (C) A qualified disabled veteran may obtain a second disabled 11 veterans license plate as described in this section for use on a 12 passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. 13 The division shall charge a one-time fee of $\$ 10$ to be deposited 14 into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by 15 this chapter, for the second plate.
(7) The division may issue recipients of the distinguished 17 Purple Heart medal special registration plates as follows:

18 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any 19 armed service person holding the distinguished Purple Heart medal 20 for persons wounded in combat a registration plate for a vehicle 21 titled in the name of the qualified applicant bearing letters or 22 numbers. The registration plate shall be designed by the 23 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and shall denote that those 24 individuals who are granted this special registration plate are

1 recipients of the Purple Heart. All letterings shall be in purple 2 where practical.
(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 4 are exempt from all registration fees otherwise required by the 5 provisions of this chapter.

6 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 7 spouse's Purple Heart medal license plate until the surviving 8 spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the license plate.
(D) A recipient of the Purple Heart medal may obtain a second 10 Purple Heart medal license plate as described in this section for 11 use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified 12 applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of $\$ 10$ to be 13 deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees 14 required by this chapter, for the second plate.

16 Harbor special registration plates as follows:
(A) Upon appropriate application, the owner of a motor vehicle 18 who was enlisted in any branch of the armed services that 19 participated in and survived the attack on Pearl Harbor on December 20 7, 1941, the division shall issue a special registration plate for 21 a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The 22 registration plate shall be designed by the Commissioner of Motor 23 Vehicles.
(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision

1 are exempt from the payment of all registration fees otherwise 2 required by the provisions of this chapter.

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(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased 4 spouse's survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate

5 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the 6 license plate.

7 (D) A survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor may obtain a 8 second survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate as 9 described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in 10 the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a 11 one-time fee of $\$ 10$ to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in 12 addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second 13 plate.

14 (9) The division may issue special registration plates to the division issue a registration plate bearing a combination of

1 letters or numbers with the organizations' logo or emblem, with the 2 maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the 3 commissioner.

4 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative 5 approval in accordance with the provisions of article three, 6 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the procedures for and 7 approval of special registration plates issued pursuant to this 8 subdivision.

9 (C) The commissioner shall set an appropriate fee to defray 10 the administrative costs associated with designing and 11 manufacturing special registration plates for a nonprofit 12 charitable or educational organization. The nonprofit charitable 13 or educational organization shall collect this fee and forward it 14 to the division for deposit in the State Road Fund. The nonprofit 15 charitable or educational organization may also collect a fee for 16 marketing the special registration plates.

17 (10) The division may issue specified emergency or volunteer 18 registration plates as follows:

19 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the 20 State of West Virginia and who is a certified paramedic or 21 emergency medical technician, a member of a paid fire department, 22 a member of the State Fire Commission, the State Fire Marshal, the 23 State Fire Marshal's assistants, the state Fire Administrator and 24 voluntary rescue squad members may apply for a special license

1 plate for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the 2 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession, 3 group or commission. Any insignia shall be designed by the 4 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 5 shall bear the requested insignia in addition to the registration 6 number issued to the applicant pursuant to the provisions of this 7 article.

8 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 9 shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the fire chief or 10 department head of the applicant stating that the applicant is 11 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia; 12 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding 13 registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all 14 required fees.

15 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 16 shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial application 17 fee of $\$ 10$, which is in addition to any other registration or 18 license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited into the State Road Fund.
(11) The division may issue specified certified firefighter registration plates as follows:
(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the State of West Virginia and who is a certified firefighter may apply for a special license plate which bears the insignia of the

1 profession, for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name 2 of the qualified applicant. Any insignia shall be designed by the 3 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision 4 shall bear the requested insignia pursuant to the provisions of 5 this article. Upon presentation of written evidence of 6 certification as a certified firefighter, certified firefighters 7 are eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued 8 pursuant to this subdivision.
(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 10 shall be accompanied by an affidavit stating that the applicant is 11 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia; 12 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding 13 registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all 14 required fees. The firefighter certification department, section 15 or division of the West Virginia University fire service extension 16 shall notify the commissioner in writing immediately when a 17 firefighter loses his or her certification. If a firefighter loses 18 his or her certification, the commissioner may not issue him or her 19 a license plate under this subsection.

20 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision 21 shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial application 22 fee of $\$ 10$, which is in addition to any other registration or 23 license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be 24 collected by the division and deposited into the State Road Fund.

(B) The division shall charge an annual fee of $\$ 15$ for each 13 special nongame wildife registration plate and each special 14 wildife registration plate in addition to all other fees required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for nongame wildife registration plates and wildife registration plates shall be deposited in a special revenue account designated the Nongame Wildlife Fund and credited to the Division of Natural Resources.

18 (i) Any license plate issued or renewed pursuant to this 19 chapter which is paid for by a check that is returned for 20 nonsufficient funds is void without further notice to the 21 applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration until 22 the returned check is paid by the applicant in cash, money order or 23 certified check and all applicable fees assessed as a result 24 thereof have been paid.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for the issuance of special license plates for the deaf or hearing impaired. The bill also exempts this plate from the minimum number of applications requirements. Application fee is set at ten dollars.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
