| 14 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: |
| 15 | That \$8-29-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, |
| 16 | be amended and reenacted to read as follows: |
| 17 | ARTICLE 29. INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS - REGIONAL AIRPORTS. |
| 18 | §8-29-4. Management of authority vested in members; appointment |
| 19 | and terms of members; vote of members; valuation of |
| 20 | property contributed to an authority; participation by |
| 21 | additional municipalities or counties without state. |
| 22 | (a) The management and control of each authority, its |
| 23 | property, operations, business and affairs shall be lodged in a |
| 24 | board of not less than five nor more than twenty-one individuals |
| 25 | who shall be known as members of the authority and who shall be |

appointed for terms of three years each by the municipalities and county courts commissions contributing moneys or property to the authority. However, the first board shall be comprised of one member appointed by each participating municipality and one member appointed by each participating county court commission, and any such member shall serve a term of one year, beginning as of the date the authority is created. No more than three members shall serve from one county on the first board.

(b) Each municipality or county shall have one vote for each 10 \$5,000 dollars it has contributed to the authority in the form of 11 moneys or property. When property is contributed, the contributing 12 municipality or county court and the authority shall agree in 13 writing at the time the contribution is made as to the fair market 14 value of such property, which valuation shall determine the number 15 of votes to be allocated to the municipality or county on the basis 16 thereof. For the fiscal year during which any authority is formed, 17 the number of votes to which any municipality or county shall be 18 entitled shall be determined as of the time of formation of the 19 authority and shall govern until the end of that fiscal year, even 20 though additional moneys or property are contributed during that 21 fiscal year. Thereafter, the number of votes shall be determined at 22 the end of each fiscal year and such determination shall govern for 23 the ensuing fiscal year, even though additional moneys or property 24 are contributed during that fiscal year. Subsequent to its

1 formation, any authority may permit any municipality or county 2 without this state to participate in the affairs of the authority, 3 to appoint members of the authority in the same manner, and to have 4 such vote or votes beginning as of the next ensuing fiscal year, as 5 prescribed by law with respect to the original participating 6 municipalities or counties or any combination thereof. The county 7 seat of the county in which the airport is situated, or 8 alternatively, the municipality wherein the airport is situated 9 shall appoint two members to the authority and each county where 10 the airport and facilities are located shall appoint five members 11 to the authority. All other participating counties may appoint one 12 member to the authority; provided however, that if the authority 13 has a number of members which is an even number, the county where 14 the majority of the airport facilities are located shall appoint 15 one additional member to the authority to provide for an odd number 16 of members.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to clarify how members of regional airport authority boards are to be allocated.
