15	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
16	by adding thereto a new section, designated \$17A-6A-19, to read as

18	ARTICLE 6A. MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS, DISTRIBUTORS, WHOLESALERS AND
19	MANUFACTURERS.
20	§17A-6A-19. Vehicle history reports for recalled vehicles.
21	Except when waived in writing by an interested potential
22	purchaser, a dealer of used motor vehicles may not fail to provide
23	a vehicle history report from a reputable source, such as Carfax or
24	a similar service, to any interested potential purchaser on any

1 used vehicle which has been the subject of a manufacturer's recall.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that used car dealers must provide vehicle history reports to persons interested in a used vehicle which has been the subject of a manufacturer's recall.
