NOTE**

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §18A-4-1b, relating to increasing pay to teachers and service personnel by one percent a year, for three years.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §18A-4-1b, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER BENEFITS.

§18A-4-1b. State minimum salaries for teachers and service personnel increased over three years.

(a) Beginning July 1, 2014, the state minimum salaries for teachers shall be as paid to teachers on July 1, 2013, in accordance with §18A-4-2 of this code, plus an additional one percent.

(b) Beginning July 1, 2015, the state minimum salaries for

1 teachers shall be as paid to teachers on July 1, 2013, in accordance
2 with §18A-4-2 of this code, plus an additional two percent.

3 (c) Beginning July 1, 2016, the state minimum salaries for
4 teachers shall be as paid to teachers on July 1, 2013, in
5 accordance with §18A-4-2 of this code, plus an additional three
6 percent.

7 (d) Beginning July 1, 2014, the minimum monthly pay for each
8 service employee shall be as mandated to be paid on July 1, 2013 in
9 accordance with §18A-4-8a of this code, plus an additional one
10 percent.

11 (e) Beginning July 1, 2015, the minimum monthly pay for each
12 service employee shall be as mandated to be paid on July 1, 2013 in
13 accordance with §18A-4-8a of this code, plus an additional two
14 percent.

15 (f) Beginning July 1, 2016, the minimum monthly pay for each
16 service employee shall be as mandated to be paid on July 1, 2013 in
17 accordance with §18A-4-8a of this code, plus an additional three
18 percent.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase pay to teachers and service personnel by one percent a year for three years.
