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10	A BILL to amend and reenact §18B-1B-6 of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to renaming the administrative
12	heads of the Potomac campus of West Virginia University and
13	the West Virginia University Institute of Technology.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That §18B-1B-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 1B. HIGHER EDUCATION POLICY COMMISSION.
18	§18B-1B-6. Appointment of institutional presidents; evaluation.
19	(a) Appointment of institutional presidents Appointment of
20	presidents of the state institutions of higher education shall be
21	made as follows:
22	(1) The initial contract term for a president of a state
23	institution of higher education may not exceed two years. At the

1 end of the initial contract period, and subject to the provisions 2 of subsection (c) of this section, the governing board may offer 3 the president a contract of longer duration, but not to exceed five

4 years.

- 5 (A) The provisions relating to initial contract periods do not 6 affect the terms of a current contract for any person holding a 7 multiyear contract and serving as president of a state institution 8 of higher education or division of a state institution of higher 9 education delivering community and technical education on June 30, 10 2008.
- 11 (B) At the end of the current contract period and thereafter,
 12 the governing board shall make presidential appointments in
 13 accordance with the provisions of this section.
- 14 (2) The person who is president, provost or divisional 15 administrative head of the community and technical college on June 16 30, 2008, becomes the president of the institution on the effective 17 date of this section.
- 18 (3) The president of a state institution of higher education 19 serves at the will and pleasure of the appointing governing board.
- 20 (4) Subject to the approval of the commission, the governing 21 board of the institution appoints a president for Bluefield State 22 College, Concord University, Fairmont State University, Glenville 23 State College, Marshall University, Shepherd University, West 24 Liberty State College, West Virginia School of Osteopathic

- 1 Medicine, West Virginia State University and West Virginia 2 University.
- 3 (5) Subject to the approval of the council, the governing
- 4 board of the community and technical college appoints a president
- 5 for Blue Ridge Community and Technical College, the Community and
- 6 Technical College at West Virginia University Institute of
- 7 Technology, Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College,
- 8 Marshall Community and Technical College, New River Community and
- 9 Technical College, Pierpont Community and Technical College,
- 10 Southern West Virginia Community and Technical College, West
- 11 Virginia Northern Community and Technical College, West Virginia
- 12 State Community and Technical College and West Virginia University
- 13 at Parkersburg.
- 14 (b) Other appointments. -- The institutional president of West
- 15 Virginia University appoints a provost president to be the
- 16 administrative head of the Potomac campus of West Virginia
- 17 University and a provost president to be the administrative head of
- 18 West Virginia University Institute of Technology.
- 19 (c) Evaluation of presidents. --
- 20 (1) The appointing governing board shall conduct written
- 21 performance evaluations of the institution's president.
- 22 Evaluations shall be done at the end of the initial two-year
- 23 contract period and in every third year of employment as president
- 24 thereafter, recognizing unique characteristics of the institution

- 1 and using institutional personnel, boards of advisors as 2 appropriate, staff of the appropriate governing board and persons 3 knowledgeable in higher education matters who are not otherwise 4 employed by a governing board. A part of the evaluation shall be 5 a determination of the success of the institution in meeting the 6 requirements of its institutional compact and in achieving the 7 goals, objectives and priorities established in articles one and 8 one-d of this chapter.
- 9 (2) After reviewing the evaluations, the board of governors
 10 shall make a determination by majority vote of its members on
 11 continuing employment and the compensation level for the president
 12 in accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of this
 13 section.
- (d) The commission and council each shall propose a rule for legislative approval in accordance with the provisions of section six, article one of this chapter and article three-a, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code by September 1, 2008, to provide guidance for the institutional governing boards in filling vacancies in the office of president in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. The rule shall include, but is not limited to, clarifying the powers, duties and roles of the governing boards, the commission, the council and the chancellors in the presidential appointment process.
- 24 (e) The Legislature finds that an emergency exists and,

- 1 therefore, the commission and the council each shall file a rule to
- 2 implement the provisions of this section as an emergency rule by
- 3 September 1, 2008, pursuant to the provisions of article three-a,
- 4 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code. The emergency rule may not be
- 5 implemented without prior approval of the Legislative Oversight
- 6 Commission on Education Accountability.
