11	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
12	designated §16-6-25, relating to food handler examinations and cards; requiring food handler
13	card within thirty days of being hired; and establishing that cards are valid for three years and
14	in all counties.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
17	section, designated §16-6-25, to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 6. HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS.
19	§16-6-25. Food handler examinations and cards.
20	Any food handler permit or card that has been issued pursuant to the procedures put in place
21	by a local county health department shall be considered a valid food handler permit or card in all
22	counties of this state, Once the food handler permit or card is issued it shall remain valid for three
23	years. A food handler permit or card is required within thirty days of being hired in a restaurant or
