20	Child Protective Services.
21	The Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services shall make an annual child
22	fatality and near fatality report to the Health and Human Resources Committees of the Senate and
23	House of Delegates based upon proceedings, records, reports, case histories and other documents of
24	the Bureau for Children and Families Child Protective Services.
