WILDLIFE RESOURCES. 17 §20-2-35. Period during which license valid. 18 Licenses and permits provided by this chapter shall be valid through the last day of the 19 calendar year for which they are issued unless otherwise provided by law: *Provided*, That all 20 hunting and fishing licenses are valid for a period of one year from the date they are issued.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to providing that all hunting and fishing licenses are valid for one year from the date issued rather than through the last day of the calendar year for which they are issued.
